ABOUT THE STANDARD BANK BIOMASS FAIR

Implemented by partners, the Namibia Biomass Industry Group (N-BiG) and the Charcoal Association of Namibia (CAoN), the Standard Bank BIOMASS FAIR is an event tailored toward the blossoming bush biomass sector in Namibia and the region at large. By bringing together stakeholders of the growing biomass sector, the sector is strengthened, and new opportunities can be explored. The annual fair provides an excellent opportunity for networking and exchanging of best practices and knowledge on bush control and biomass utilisation. The Standard Bank BIOMASS FAIR takes place over three days, comprising a Conference, an Expo showcasing technology and field demonstrations and a Networking event. Each specific event is targeted and has a specific purpose, with the overall aim of formalising and promoting the budding biomass industry in Namibia.

With approximately 300 visitors and 30 local exhibitors, the Biomass Technology Demonstration Day at Cheetah Conservation Fund in 2018 was a successful pilot event that paved the way for the foundation of this annual biomass event. In 2019, the Biomass Technology Expo drew over 1,500 international, regional, and local visitors, as well as 120 exhibitors to Otjiwa Lodge in the Otjozondjupa region, the central hub of bush biomass in Namibia. From 7 to 8 September 2022 N-BiG, NUST and CAoN hosted a two-day Standard Bank BIOMASS FAIR comprising a Research Symposium and Biomass Industry Conference at the Safari Court Hotel and Conference Centre in Windhoek, under the theme “Discovering A New Decade for Biomass.” The Standard Bank BIOMASS FAIR 2022 received diamond sponsorship from Standard Bank Namibia, thus accorded the name Standard Bank BIOMASS FAIR 2022. The event attracted over 500 participants and over 20 local and international speakers.

In 2023, the Standard Bank BIOMASS FAIR at Gross Barmen attracted over 250 participants to the conference, 60 exhibitors as well as over 23 local and international speakers. This was the first full event after a 3-year break due to COVID-19. To supplement the financial efforts of the implementing partners, an annual call for sponsorships is advertised for interested companies.

The Standard Bank BIOMASS FAIR 2024, held from 8–10 August in Otjiwarongo under the theme “Innovating for a greener future,” brought together stakeholders from across the biomass sector for knowledge sharing and networking. Standard Bank Namibia once again served as the diamond sponsor, reaffirming its commitment to supporting sustainable energy solutions and promoting a greener future. The event featured a conference with 260 in-person and over 1,500 online participants, 19 speakers, a biomass expo with 64 exhibitors and 450 visitors, and a networking event connecting buyers and sellers in a relaxed setting.

MORE ABOUT THE STANDARD BANK BIOMASS FAIR 2026

The Standard Bank BIOMASS FAIR 2026 is an event tailored towards the blossoming biomass sector in Namibia and the region at large. The Standard Bank BIOMASS FAIR event will take place over three days from 6 to 8 August 2026, comprising a Biomass Conference, Networking Event and the Expo. Each specific event is targeted, and has a specific purpose, with the overall aim of formalising and promoting the budding biomass industry in Namibia.

The 2026 FAIR will be taking place in Otjiwarongo, the hub for the wood biomass industry in Namibia. The Biomass Conference will be held at a suitable conference centre in Otjiwarongo. The conference will be followed by a Networking Event at 19:00. The Expo will be held at the Sekelbos/TOPS terrain on the road to the Otjiwarongo small-holdings.





YOU ARE INVITED TO EXHIBIT

You are invited to be part of this auspicious event as an exhibitor for the Expo, all exhibitors are to exhibit on two days, Friday, 7 August 2026 and Saturday, 8 August 2026.

By joining the Standard Bank BIOMASS FAIR 2026, you will have access to over 1000 potential visitors, you would not want to miss this opportunity!

Exhibitors are responsible for bringing their own tent and gazebo, as these items are not provided by the Standard Bank BIOMASS FAIR. However, we offer two (2) chairs, one (1) table, ample space and assistance for setup upon arrival. The fair accommodates both demonstrations and regular exhibitions, with a designated demonstration area separate from the main exhibition space, allowing exhibitors to effectively showcase products through practical demonstrations, which cannot be conducted within the exhibition area. Exhibitors interested in demonstrating equipment on a larger scale should indicate their preference for using the demonstration area. Smaller and quieter equipment demonstrations are permitted within the exhibition area, with a reminder to maintain consideration for neighbouring stalls and avoid disruption.

COST AND ADMISSION FEES

All the ticket prices include VAT.

- All exhibitors will receive 2 free tickets for entrance to the exhibition area. Exhibitors that need the demonstration area will receive 3 tickets.
- Entrance to the **Conference** is free of charge, however, **attendees must register for the event.**
